

In summer, Avignon features the products from these estates at its beautiful Estivales du Rhône festival.

Maison Pic

Restaurant and hotel in town. Taking inspiration from the world of perfume, and drawing on the aromatic composition of each ingredient, to create sauces of astonishing complexity; awakening childhood memories by marrying orange blossom with carrot to enhance its flavor; or constructing a dessert like a monochrome painting: Anne-Sophie Pic's approach to cuisine is a sensitive and evocative one. Enriched by her travels and personal encounters and conveying emotions she wants to share, this celebrated chef's dishes are rich storytelling creations. In unison, the hotel is a refined destination, contemporary yet warm, and surrounded by delightful Mediterranean gardens where you can swim surrounded by olive trees and roses.

Le Mas des Herbes Blanches

Hotel and restaurant in the country. With its breathtaking views of the Luberon valley, this Provencal farmhouse is the perfect place to relax. Witness unforgettable sunsets to the song of chirping cicadas from the terraces of the mas with its sun-bleached walls. The Mas des Herbes Blanches is set around a magnificent pool, surrounded by cypresses, olive trees, mediterranean pines and palm trees. From here, discover the charms of the Vaucluse, with its watermills, windmills and dry stone huts – a beautiful part of the world that has seduced and inspired a number of great artists including Marc Chagall, Serge Poliakoff and Victor Vasarely as a living painting.

Le Phébus & Spa - Villa des Anges

Hotel and restaurant in the country. This beautiful stone farmhouse, so typical of the Provençal landscape, is located on the Luberon hills between the famous villages of Gordes and Roussillon. The Phébus & Spa-Villa des Anges hotel occupies a historic site whose origins date back to the Knights of the Order of Malta. From the light-colored walls to the ocher of the tiles, the changing hues of the pines and olive trees and the blue of the panoramic swimming pool, a true symphony of colors welcomes guests into the soft light of Provence. In the gourmet restaurant of this family-owned property, Chef Xavier Mathieu prepares regional produce-including vegetables cultivated on site-which diners can enjoy at the Table du Jardinier. This exclusive dining spot, located directly in the kitchen garden, is the ideal spot to sample specialties like vegetable pesto, basil and garlic soup. A similar sense of authenticity can be found in the spa, where treatments and massages use essential oils from the surrounding lavender fields.

VILLENEUVE LEZ AVIGNON — 1 NIGHT

Le Prieuré Baumanière

Hotel and restaurant in a village. Le Prieuré in Villeneuve-lez-Avignon, tucked away in the mediaeval village, with its cottage garden and its trailing wisteria, emanates a rare charm. Jean-André and Geneviève Charial, who also own two properties in Les Baux-de-Provence, say that this former convent epitomises silence and relaxation. In the different rooms and suites contemporary style meets ancient tradition. The menu also pays tribute to the region, with dishes such as duck foie gras with Gariquette strawberries from Nîmes and potroasted Costières wood pigeon with fresh sage. Le Prieuré's mouth-watering cuisine is served in surroundings which bring all the senses to life.

4 UZÈS — 1 NIGHT

La Maison d'Uzès

Hotel and restaurant in a village. This 300-year-old house, tucked away in an alley of the majestic city of Uzès, was once the home of the Chambon de La Tour family. Now a historic monument, it has recovered all of its former glory. Behind its imposing façade, a monumental 17th-century staircase and hidden passage lead to guest rooms featuring contemporary decor and picturesque views over the roofs of the old town. The spa is nestled under Romanesque arches and draws its inspiration from ancient traditions of health and well-being. At La Table d'Uzès, Michelin-starred chef Christophe Ducros serves Provençal market cuisine, which can be enjoyed on the patio during summer.
